At the south of Osaka Bay, there is unbelievably quiet and beautiful sea. It's 「Tannowa」 .

In 1937, 「Osaka Golf Club 」 was born in this area by the founders who loved golf greatly. The course was designed by Mr. Osamu Ueda, a famous Japanese Golf Course Designer.

He left the nature of terrain as much as possible and 18 holes show the various expressions respectively. He also made undulations on the fairway, made the course three-dimensional with the mounting green and Alison bunkers, and arranged the green diagonally. Such a course makes players tough and will be more difficult if the sea breeze blows.

It is the true point of Mr. Osamu Ueda who is regarded as masculine and Osaka Golf Club is his real masterpiece. There are 9 holes facing the sea and you may also feel refreshed by the sound of waves.

The History

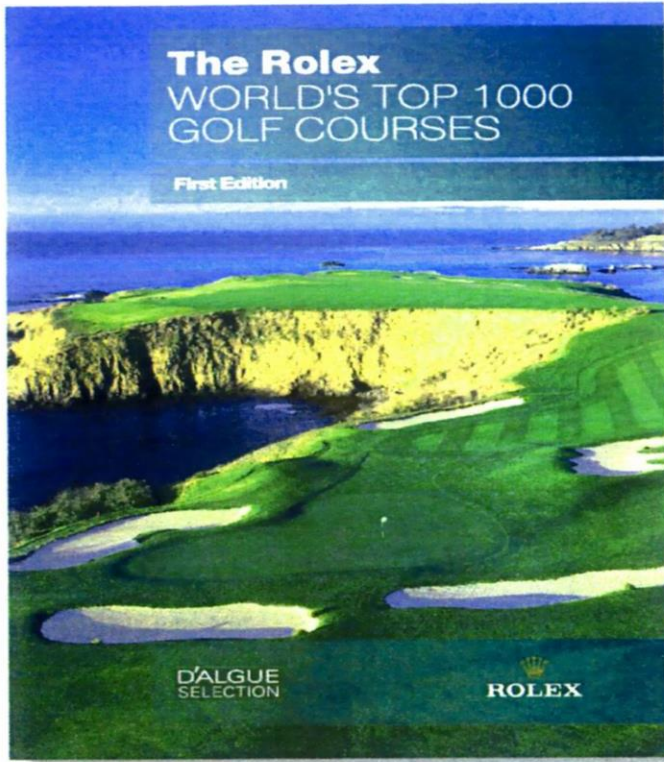
- 1936 Jinkichi Terada establishes Osaka Golf Club

- 1937 Holds “Kansai Professional Championship” for 4 days
- 1944 Closes the course due to the world war II
- 1953 Reopens Osaka Golf Club
- 2017 Celebrates the 80th anniversary
